





GCSAA ANNUAL MEETING JAN. 30, 1993 ANAHEIM CONVENTION CENTER - ANAHEIM. CA.

The GCSAA annual membership meeting was opened at 8:00 A.M. by President William Roberts. After numerous formalities the By-law proposals were voted upon. The Central Pa. GCSA voting delegate, Dave Rafferty and Alternate, Sam Snyder were present. Dave Rafferty voted the 69 CPGCSA votes as previously discussed by the board, past-presidents and membership. The following are the results of the by-law vote. 2/3rd majority needed to pass.

Only By-law proposal A was accepted. 5433 votes were cast. 250 proxy votes were cast by Pres. Roberts.

Presidential candidate Randy Nichols, Georgia, ran unopposed and was unanimously elected.

VP Candidates Joe Baidy and Gary Grigg ran with Joe Baidy receiving all 69 CPGCSA votes and all the votes from Pa. Totals: Baidy 3248 - Grigg 1879, Baidy was elected. A total of 5127 votes were cast. Pres. Roberts cast no proxy votes.


Director Candidates Dave Fearis, Joe Hahn, Charles Passios, and George Renault ran with defeated V.P. candidate Gary Grigg being nominated from the floor. CPGCSA cast 69 votes each for David Fearis, Joe Hahn, and George Renault. The Allied GCS of Pa. met in caucus the previous evening to discuss the election and throughout the state each candidate received support. This election was somewhat heated due to a controversy over the candidates positions on the proposed by-laws. The results were as follows:

Hahn	1481
Passios	2041
Renault	3453

Fearis, Grigg, and Renault were elected. Hahn and Passios, who were both incumbents were defeated. A total of 15,178 votes were cast. Pres. Roberts cast no proxy votes.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:45 P.M.
