## CPGCSA BOARD NEWS

The annual meeting of the Central Pennsylvania Golf Course Superintendents Association was held at Hershey Country Club, Tuesday, October 12, 1993. The meeting was opened by President Dave Rafferty at 7:20 P.M. He thanked Matt Shaffer and the entire staff at Hershey Country Club for a great day. He noted that everyone was sorry that it rained and that we haven't really had a chance to enjoy it since many of the people were looking forward to playing the course knowing its excellent reputation.

The Treasurer's report was given. The income as of this date is \$18,135.90. Expenses were \$11,138.10 and our balance in the checkbook as of this day is \$6,789.73. Mel Leaver, Membership Chairman, introduced Sherri Kuehne (Class B) as the newest member of the association. She was welcomed to the association warmly. Jim Jones, Judge of Elections, began the election process. His helpers passed out ballots while Jim noted that Class AA, A, B, C, and R members were eligible to vote. Jim announced that for President, Tony Goodley had been nominated and asked for nominations from the floor. With no nominations forthcoming, Jim declared that Tony Goodley is the new President of Central Penn GCSA. Jim then announced that for Vice President the nomination of Sam Snyder and asked for floor nominations. No nominations were forthcoming. Jim declared Sam Snyder Vice President of Central Penn GCSA. For Secretary/Treasurer, Ken Pepple and John Dougherty had been nominated. Jim opened the floor for nominations and none were forthcoming and the election process began. After votes were counted John Dougherty was elected as Secretary/Treasurer of Central Penn GCSA. For Director Jim read the list of nominees: John Gehman, Matt Shaffer, H. Jim Loke, Ken McFadden, and Mark Hendrixson. Jim opened the floor for nominations and none were forthcoming and the election proceeded. The counting of ballots — John Gehman and Matt Shaffer were elected Directors of Central Penn GCSA for a three-year term.

In the meantime, Golf Chairman, John Dougherty passed out trophies. The Club Championship of the Association was won by Jeff Shockley, First Flight went to John Dougherty, Second Flight went to Thomas Ocepek, and Third Flight went to Bill Corcoran.

At this point in the meeting, President Dave Rafferty and incoming President Tony Goodley both went to the podium and Dave passed the gavel to Tony Goodley and made a few remarks expressing his gratitude to the association for all the help he has received and fond memories which he will always carry with him of being President of Central Penn. Tony then presented Dave with a Past President's plaque. Tony noted the many things that Dave had been involved with and is still involved with and will be involved with in the future. Also, noted Dave and John Chassard, both members of Central Penn are running for the PTC Board of Directors. We ask that you support both of these gentlemen and then Tony spoke of his hopes to have a smooth year as President of Central Penn and hoping to move forward with the Association.

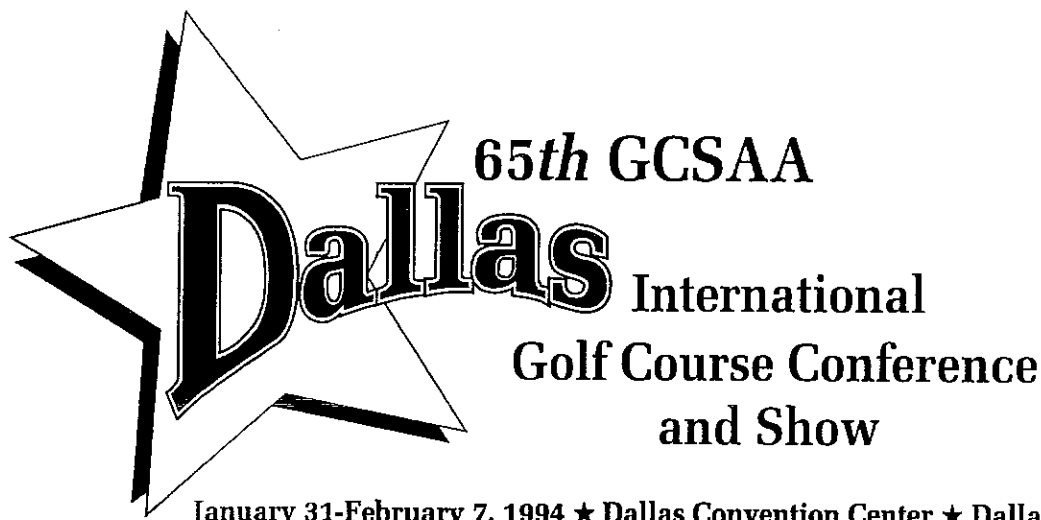

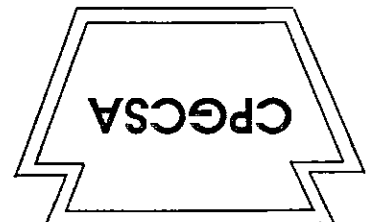
