Drought Emergency Declared In Pennsylvania

As you may already be aware, Governor Schweiker has declared a drought emergency for 24 counties in Pennsylvania. Counties included in this emergency area are Adams, Berks, Dauphin, Lancaster, Lebanon, and York.

The use of water for irrigating golf course turf has been declared non-essential. However, a Golf Course Drought Emergency Operations Plan can be obtained from the web-site and once it is filed, specific and defined irrigation practices can be employed.
