Directions to Lebanon Country Club

From PA Turnpike:

Route 72 North to 322 West towards Hershey. Approximately 5 miles make a right onto Route 934 North. Make second right onto Church Road. Church Road will end at stop sign and Oak Street begins. Go straight to Y, stay left of Y. Club is ½ mile on left on Oak Street.

From I-81:

Take 934 South through Annville. Make a left onto Royal Road. At the second stop sign make a left onto Oak Street. Club entrance is ½ mile on left.

From Harrisburg via Route 322:

Route 322 East through Hershey. Make a left onto Route 934 North. Make right onto Church Road (second road). At the stop sign go straight to Y, stay to left of Y. Oak Street begins, the club entrance is ½ mile on the left.

From Reading via Route 422:

Take Route 422 West to Lebanon till 16th Street. Make a left onto 16th Street. Three blocks to Oak Street. Make right onto Oak Street. The club entrance is on the right (2 miles).

From Lancaster via Route 72:

Route 72 North to Route 322 West towards Hershey. Approximately 5 miles make right onto Route 934 North. Make the second right onto Church Road, go to stop sign. Go straight to Y, stay to left of Y. Oak Street begins and the club entrance is $\frac{1}{2}$ mile on the left on Oak Street.
