Superintendent Profile

Patrick Michener became the Superintendent at the Country Club of York in January of 2013. Before Country Club of York, Patrick was an Assistant Superintendent at Aronimink Golf Club in Philadelphia region and an Assistant Superintendent at Bidermann Golf Club in the Wilmington, Delaware area. Patrick graduated from Penn State University with a BS in Turfgrass Science in 2006.

Golf Club Profile

At a Country Club of York Board of Directors meeting on January 13, 1923, there was a proposal made by C. Elmer Smith on the possibility of looking for a location to build a new eighteen-hole course and a modern clubhouse. It was not until the following year on January 12, 1924 that the board of directors formed a committee to investigate locations and make recommendations for a new country club. In May of 1926, the committee chose Donald Ross and Associates to design the golf course. Mr. Ross tramped over the terrain and plotted the course. The course combined natural hazards of the terrain with artificial lakes and bunkers for a total of 6,550 yards for play with a par 72. The course remains as the great architect had intended and offers a great variety in playability, member enjoyment, and views of surrounding farm land.

SRBC Update

The next meeting of the PA State Legislature is Monday June 26th at 9:00 am in the Shrewsbury Borough Municipal Building, 35 West Railroad Avenue, Shrewsbury, PA 17361.

The meeting held on June 12th went very well. Members of Central Penn as well as Keystone were in attendance. The committee heard testimony from Andrew Dehoff of SRBC, two municipal water suppliers as well as myself. There were 17 state reps present. They questioned Dehoff on excessive charges, SRBC's mission, redundancies with DEP, staff compensation and benefits, intimidation tactics and overreach. The committee appears to have a unified opinion the commission has gone way beyond the boundaries of the compact of 1968. My testimony was very well received and the meeting exceeded my expectations. This issue is picking up steam fast and now is our time to be heard. I was asked to testify again at the next meeting.

Any input you have would be appreciated. Please call or email me. The biggest impact we can have is a attendance to the upcoming meeting in Shrewsbury. I need 50+ people to show up. There will be ample opportunity to speak one on one with the representatives after the meeting. They have a lot of questions and are very empathetic to consumptive users. Please clear your schedules and attend the meeting!

CPGCSA Bylaw Vote to Change Class SM (Superintendent Member) to Class B

Old Version--

Section 6.07. Class SM - Golf Course Superintendent Members. A Golf Course Superintendent is one who is entrusted with the management and operation of the tract of land defined as a golf course, including involvement in construction and maintenance of golf courses and related equipment. To qualify for a Class SM membership, an applicant shall have, at the time of application for membership, less than three (3) years experience as a Golf Course Superintendent and be currently employed in such capacity. Effective July 1,1997, all Class SM membership applicants must submit an application for membership or evidence of membership, with the Golf Course Superintendents Association of America and must maintain that membership thereafter. Class SM members shall have all the privileges of the association subject to the provisions of Article II. Section II, and shall pay such Initiation fees, annual dues and assessments as established by the board.

New Version --

Section 6.07. Class B - Golf Course Superintendent Members. A Golf Course Superintendent is one who is entrusted with the management and operation of the tract of land defined as a golf course, including involvement in construction and maintenance of golf courses and related equipment. To qualify for a Class B membership, an applicant shall have, at the time of application for membership, less than three (3) years experience as a Golf Course Superintendent and be currently employed in such capacity. Effective July 1,1997, all Class B membership applicants must submit an application for membership or evidence of membership, with the Golf Course Superintendents Association of America and must maintain that membership thereafter. Class B members shall have all the privileges of the association subject to the provisions of Article II. Section II, and shall pay such Initiation fees, annual dues and assessments as established by the board.
